Sherlock Holmes

Director

A man arrives at 221B Baker Street to ask for Sherlock Holmes's help. Holmes and Dr Watson are having breakfast when a man arrives and tells them about the mysterious Hound of the Baskervilles.

Dr Watson

You are the famous detective's friend and assistant. You are having breakfast with him when Dr Mortimer arrives to ask for his help.

Scene designer

Sherlock Holmes and Dr Watson are having breakfast in their flat. They are wearing comfortable suits. The story is set in London in the 19th century. You can change the setting to modern-day London. Dr Mortimer has a yellow paper with the story of the Hound of the Baskervilles, and he also has a local newspaper.

Dr Mortimer

You are a country doctor. You visit Sherlock Holmes to tell him about the mysterious story of a dangerous dog in your village. You look very worried. You are tall and thin, and you wear glasses.

Costume designer

Sherlock Holmes and Dr Watson are having breakfast in their flat. They are wearing comfortable suits. Dr Mortimer has a coat over his suit. He is wearing glasses.
